

Jo Ellen Hylind is a highly respected senior executive with over twenty years experience in health care quality measurement and improvement, including advanced data management and analysis, and promotion of electronic health record systems for health information exchange. In 1984 Ms Hylind co-founded Lumetra, an independent, nonprofit organization dedicated to improving the quality, safety and integrity of healthcare through independent review, scientific analysis, quality measurement and improvement programs, expert consultation in adoption and use of health information technology, and promotion of health information exchange. She led Lumetra as President and CEO for over 20 years. Additionally, from 2005-2008, Ms Hylind served on the Board of California Regional Health Information Organization (CalRHIO), and in 2004 on the Executive Committee of the California Health Information Exchange Project.
